## Request for full disclosure of mix design information for BC MOTI submissions (revised October 2023)

To Whom It May Concern,

Upon in depth consideration by Concrete BC's Technical Committee, Concrete BC's position on the request for full disclosure of concrete mix designs to the BC Ministry of Transportation and Infrastructure (MOTI) is that concrete mix designs are proprietary intellectual property of the Ready Mix Concrete Producer and in general should not be disclosed in order to prevent this proprietary information from being inadvertently presented to a third party.

It is up to the individual Ready Mix Concrete Producers to decide whether they want to disclose Mix Design Information or enter into any type of confidentiality agreements with respect to this information.

Concrete BC recognizes that BC MOTI has taken the position that the full mix design information is required documentation for projects and that this information may be shared with relevant third parties. Concrete BC is continuing to work with BC MOTI to work towards a mutually agreeable process to manage mix design information.
